



2017 Brussels Study Tour

The Jean Monnet European Union Centre of Excellence (JMEUCE) at UW-Madison is pleased to announce this year's teacher study trip to Brussels, Belgium. The study trip will take place June 18th to June 24th, and our Center will be providing travel grants to support one Wisconsin community college educator and one undergraduate to attend this five-day long trip.

The study tour is organized in partnership with a number of universities with a European area studies center across the United States. Therefore, educators and students get the opportunity to experience Brussels with their peers from around the country. During the tour, participants will engage in a variety of site visits to learn more about the European Union – how it is organized, what it does, and how non-EU institutions work with the EU. Past trips have included visits to European Union institutions (the European Parliament, the European Commission), NATO, the US Mission and think tank/consulting institutions. All visits will be conducted as a group.

UW-Madison JMEUCE will cover the cost of flights and accommodations for the successful applicants, and provide a limited subsistence allowance for the week. Costs of travel insurance, most meals, ground transportation from the airport to your hotel, and incidentals will not be covered. Participants will have the opportunity to extend their trip at their own expense.
